

118 CAMPERS AT CAMP GROWTORAH

We spent a gorgeous 2 week on the farm for the two sessions of Camp GrowTorah 2022. This year's theme was Shmita, and each day we explored a different element of the mitzvah. Specifically, we learned about how Shmita affects the land, the animals, the needy among us, and of course, our relationship with Hashem. We did this through nature exploration, arts & crafts, and farm chores in both the learning garden and in the farm fields.

Our Shorashim partner garden programs are thriving under the guidance of our educators: For Rosh Hashana Farmer Yosef taught "teshuva weeding" at Yeshivat Frisch, Ben Porat Yosef and SAR Academy; Farmer Sara led life-cycle explorations and said goodbye to our experiential shmita garden beds at Yavneh Academy and The Moriah School. For Sukkot, Farmer Menuchah explored the Arba Minim and other plant-based mitzvot at Kushner Hebrew Academy, Mercaz Academy, The Leffell School and HALB's Lev Chana. At Yeshivah of Flatbush, Barkai Yeshiva, North Shore Hebrew Academy and the Kaplen JCC's Ginat Yachad, Farmer Spence guided students through Parshat Beresheit with examples of creation in our gardens.





ANAFIM ACROSS THE USA

Each month our Anafim educators gather for our cohort-wide professional development workshops. This month we focused on seed-saving for parshat Beresheit, cover cropping during shmita and fall planting to learn shabbos melachot. Each school customizes their program to fit their community and we are honored to partner with all of these schools: Akiba Yavneh Academy (Dallas, TX), Berman Hebrew Academy (Silver Spring, MD); Hebrew Academy of the Five Towns of Rockaway - HAFTR (Lawrence, NY); Hebrew Academy of Nassau County - HANC (West Hempstead, NY); Hillel Torah (Skokie, IL); Ohr Hatorah (Atlanta, GA); and Yeshiva Har Torah (Queens, NY).
